Ehsaas Emergency Cash Information Portal

Ehsaas Emergency Cash operations worth Rs. 144 billion have been ongoing since April 9, 2020. Under the program, disbursements of Rs. 12,000 each are being made to 12 million beneficiaries across the country to support deserving families affected by COVID-19 restrictions.

In interest of transparency, Ehsaas has released an information portal relating to Ehsaas Emergency Cash disbursements.

Till the launch of the portal on April 24, 2020, overall disbursements of Rs. 68.946 billion has been made to 5.745 million beneficiaries across the country for categories 1 and 2.

Ehsaas regards transparency and integrity is the foremost principle of Ehsaas Emergency Cash disbursements. In this regard, an information portal has been released by Ehsaas.

Dashboards in the portal give details about the number of beneficiaries served in each of the three categories with provincial, district and tehsil wise breakdowns.

With great transparency, it outlines the amounts given to partnering banks for disbursements to beneficiaries, and the number of beneficiaries who have taken out money.

This portal has been made public to enable people to access information in real time.

Prime Minister approved the launch of the portal on April 22, 2020. Dr. Sania Nishtar, Special Assistant to the PM on Social Protection and Poverty Alleviation officially released the portal in a press conference at Press Information Department on April 24, 2020.
